

# **GUERRIERO DELLA TERRA**

-Marche IGT Rosso-

#### REGION

From 1800, Azienda Agraria Guerrieri is located in Marche region on the East Coast of Italy facing the Adriatic Sea. The vineyards are at 12 km from the sea at an altitude of 200m a.s.l.. Our area is called "Valle del Metauro" for the historical Metauro river that crosses all the valley.

#### CLIMATE

Mild and harmonious climate, with important thermal excursions and windy. Influenced by the Adriatic sea at East and from the Appennini mountains at West.

# SOIL

Eastern bank of the Metauro River. The formation consists of grayish calcareous mud, which turns light blue just a few meters deep. The vegetative soil is predominantly silty clay loam with small carbonate nodules originating from water erosion and from the transformation of inorganic vegetative matter into humus.

# STORY OF THE WINE

This wine was born from the desire to demonstrate how the Marche region can be unique in its kind. We understood that our oldest vineyard, in certain years is able to bring a great identity under an overripe condition of the grapes.



#### VINEYARD and HARVEST

AGE OF THE VINEYARD: 35 years old, oldest vineyard of the farm.

VINETYPE: Montepulciano/Sangiovese.

DENSITY: 3300 plants/hectar.

EXPOSITION: S-S/W.

HARVEST: Grapes are left in the vineyard for more than one month from the maturation point. We obtain an overripe in the vineyard, thanks to the sun and the constant wind of our valley. Manual grapes harvest in cassetts during October and November.

### **GRAPE VARIETY**

90% Montepulciano and 10 % Sangiovese

### VINIFICATION and AGEING

Long maceration and controlled fermentation. Refined in big Italian oak for over a year. Further 1 year in the bottle, AGEING POTENTIALITY IN BOTTLE UNTIL: 2025
